#### GOSPEL: Mark 13:1-8

This is our confidence indeed:





Those who are worshipping in person are invited to dispose of their communion packs and greet one another with a sign of Christ's peace.




Jesus told Peter that even though the temple towers will fall over, he should not be afraid. God is working for good!
