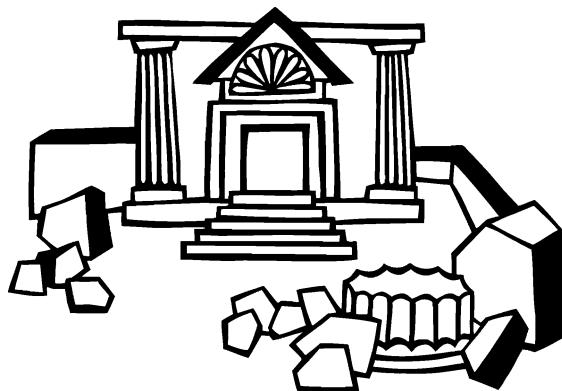

knows very well the fears we face.

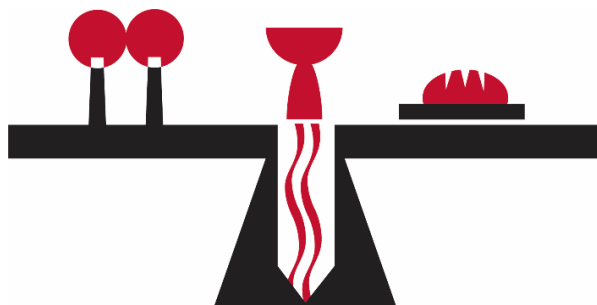
Sing, pray, and keep God's ways unswerving,
